Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):

Head Cook - for breakfast and dinner and works with Patrol and Troop QuarterMasters to obtain food, and then prepare it.

Asst. Cook - works with head cook to prepare breakfast and dinner.

Campsite Cleaner - keeps patrol and troop common areas clean and neat.

Asst. Campsite Cleaner - works with campsite cleaner to keep patrol and troop common areas clean and neat.

Waterman - provides in-camp drinking, cooking and wash water needs for patrol and troop for the day.

Kitchen Cleaner - clean and stores kitchen utensels, pots, pans and kitchen area after breakfast and dinner, including making sure all waste is disposed of properly.

Asst. Kitchen Cleaner - helps kitchen cleaner.

Note: Troop and Patrol Leaders may request additional assistance from time to time, please be helpful, friendly, and trustworthy (not to mention the rest)! Also, adjust duties as needed to the event(s).
